## **Application Requirements**

We will judge essays on adherence to the chosen topic, authentic voice, logical support of thesis, clarity, and organization. We expect students will keep in mind the above core values of Humanism in their approach to the topic.

1. An original essay of 750 to 1,000 words, typed and double-spaced, on one of the following topics:

- a. If you were the CEO of a large company how might you use your company to address our nation's income inequality. How would you deal with criticism of your policies?
- b. What role can an individual play in combatting climate change? The community? The government?
- c. Religion tangled up with law is being used as a weapon against individuals because of their gender, sexual orientation, race, and ethnicity. What can/should be done to ensure that our laws and their application are free from such bias?
- 2. A one-paragraph autobiography including interests, activities, and college goals.
- 3. High school transcript showing GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 4. Copy of student's driver's license or state-issued photo ID to verify Oregon or Washington residence.
- 5. Completed application with parent's or guardian's signed permission.
